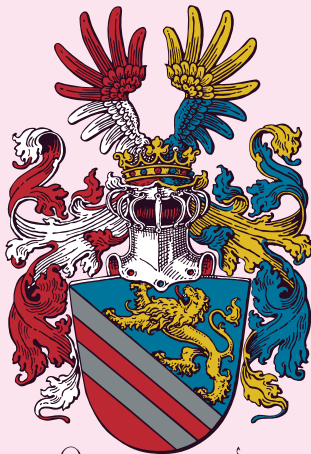


# Seebass

### **Seebass (Say-Bass):**

- Brigitte Seebass, the founder and vineyard owner, was originally from Germany
- The name is derived from the old German name Sebastian
- The family crest: Originally drawn by the Seebass family friar or pastor in 1386
- Family originated in the area of Germany that is now Bavaria
- Family members have lived on the 100-acre vineyard in Mendocino County for 30 years and grow five varietals: Grenache, Chardonnay, Syrah, Merlot and Zinfandel

### **Details:**

- Released and bottled on Valentine's Day 2014 (Michelle, the winery owner's birthday) - 263 cases made
- 100% Estate-grown Grenache fruit, hand-harvested, hand-pruned
- Made by French winemaker Stéphane Vivier (**Shteh-fan Vivee-ay**)
- Long, slow 100% Malolactic Fermentation, fermented in 100% stainless steel barrels
- 13.7% alc. medium acid

### **Tasting Notes:**

- Pink-Orange hue typical of Provence-style (**Pro-vaunce**) wine region of France well-known for Rosé
- Nose (smell) of baking spice, orange peel, and tart red fruit (strawberry, cherry)
- Flavors echo the scent, the finish rewards with a hint of nutmeg
